This was probably asked before, but I couldn't find it.

I'd like to program my images in the command line. The script is approximately like this:

./bin/windows64/t32mppc64.exe -c ./config_P1.t32 -s flash_binaries_cmd.cmm img1.BIN img2.BIN

However, this call returns immediately, it opens a new Trace32 window and all the output goes there. Is it possible to configure t32mppc64.exe so that it blocks until flash binaries cmd.cmm is done and all the output goes into the shell it was called from?
