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What does the message “fatal error #<code>” mean?

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The error message “fatal error #<code>” (e.g. “fatal error #FF”) indicates that an internal error has occurred inside the TRACE32 software or hardware. This means that TRACE32 has encountered an unexpected situation that should not normally happen during standard operation.

Please [report this issue to Lauterbach Technical Support](#) and include the following information to help us investigate:

- The complete error message (including the error code)
- A short description of what you were doing when the error occurred (commands executed, action performed, etc.)
- A system information report about your TRACE32 configuration (TRACE32 menu 'Help' > 'Support' > 'System Information...', click 'Save to File')

The error code itself is used internally by Lauterbach to identify the cause of the problem and does not have a specific meaning for the user.
